QUALIFYING PROCEDURE

Only Competitors who are entered for the Event, pass inspection and possess a current unrestricted 2026 CARS Tour Driver's License will be eligible.

Two consecutive qualifying laps. Faster lap determines qualifying position. Adjustments or repairs may not be made on the vehicle after the vehicle has taken the green flag at the start/finish line.

All cars will be impounded after Qualifying. All cars must participate in the Qualifying Procedure "RACE READY." Work will not be permitted on any car after Qualifying / before the Race with the exception of "approved adjustments" permitted by the CARS Tour Technical Director at a designated time.

STARTING POSITIONS AND **PROVISIONAL STARTING POSITIONS**

The starting field for this event will be established as follows:

Starting positions 1st through 30th will be determined by qualifying

Provisional Starting Position 31st has been established for the highest ranking of the Top 30 Car Owners in the final 2025 CARS Tour Late Model Stock Car owner point standings who has not yet qualified for the Event.

Provisional Starting Position 32nd has been established for the highest ranking of the Top 30 Car Owners in the final 2025 CARS Tour Late Model Stock Car owner point standings who has not yet qualified for the Event.

Provisional Starting Position 33rd has been established for the highest ranking of the Top 30 Car Owners in the final 2025 CARS Tour Late Model Stock Car owner point standings who has not yet qualified for the Event.

Provisional Starting Position 34th has been established for the highest ranking of the Top 30 Car Owners in the final 2025 CARS Tour Late Model Stock Car owner point standings who has not yet qualified for the Event.

Provisional Starting Position 35th has been established for the highest ranking of the Top 30 Car Owners in the final 2025 CARS Tour Late Model Stock Car owner point standings who has not yet qualified for the Event.

Provisional Starting Position 36th has been established for the highest ranking of the Top 30 Car Owners in the final 2025 CARS Tour Late Model Stock Car owner point standings who has not yet qualified for the Event.

If Provisional Starting Positions 31st thru 36th remain unfilled, then those position(s) will become available to the next eligible car from the Qualifying Procedure

Provisional Starting Position 37th has been established for the most recent CARS Tour Late Model Stock Car Past Champion Driver who has not yet qualified for the Event. If there are no Past Champions in need of this provisional starting position, it will not be filled.

Provisional Starting Position 38th has been established as a “Promoter’s Choice” provisional. If the “Promoter’s Choice” provisional is not used, it will not be filled.

RACE RULES & FORMAT

ENTRY REGULATIONS

Entries must be filed and paid in full via the Pit Pay App. Telephone, email and/or faxed entries will not be accepted. CARS Tour is under no obligation to accept any entry. Entry / Inspection fees are non-refundable and may not be carried over to a future event.

ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS

The event shall be run in accordance with all of the applicable CARS Tour Rules, the provisions of this Official Entry Blank, any special rules applicable to this event and any amendments thereto. In the event of any conflict between the Rule Book, the Official Entry Form and the special rules, CARS Tour determination as to the interpretation and application of the conflicting rules will be final. All drivers and car owners must have a valid CARS Tour License that is not currently suspended or revoked. All engine fluids,

lubricants, solvents and fuels must be disposed of in a manner in accordance with track rules and procedures and all other applicable federal, state and local laws and regulations. All cars must be inspected by CARS Tour prior to being permitted to engage in practice or time trials. Cars that have not been checked in for inspection during the inspection period may not be permitted to compete (EIRI). All cars are subject to the control of CARS Tour from the time they enter pit area until they are officially released by CARS Tour. CARS Tour is not responsible for any loss or damage to any car.

MANDATORY BREAK: The Race will be divided into two (2) segments. The caution will be displayed at or around lap sixty (60) and, at the direction of CARS Tour Officials, the field will be brought onto pit road for a five (5) minute break. During this break, teams will be permitted to make adjustments and add fuel. Teams will not be permitted to change tires.

CARS TOUR TIRE RULE:

LS - Hoosier F-45* RS – Hoosier ST3*

MAXIMUM of twelve (12) tires may be purchased for the Event. Eight (8) tires to be used for practice and four (4) tires to be used for qualifying and the race. Cars must race on the tires in which they qualified. Any tire changes during the race will result in a two (2) lap penalty unless the car enters the pits with the tire flat on the rim. The only tires that may be used during an approved change are ones that have been purchased at the track during the current Event.

OFFICIAL FUEL: “Sunoco Standard 110 Purple” is the only fuel approved for use. Fuel used in competition must meet the same specifications as the fuel dispensed from the Official Supplier’s station at the venue.

SOUND REQUIREMENT: Mufflers are required. Cars must not exceed a maximum sound level of 99dB maximum @100 feet. Sound level measurements will be acquired using the Nashville sound meter at the Nashville Fairgrounds designated location only. Any cars exceeding the maximum sound level during on-track activity will be black flagged and will be required to take corrective action before they are allowed to continue. Any car exceeding the maximum allowable dB reading may be subject to a CARS Tour penalty.

EACH CAR MUST HAVE ONE (1) SPOTTER IN THE OFFICIAL SPOTTERS’ LOCATION WITH CAPABILITY OF MONITORING CARS Tour RACE CONTROL OR CAR WILL NOT BE ALLOWED TO COMPETE.

DISCLAIMER

To qualify entrant for driver and/or car owner CARS Tour Championship points, this entry form should be completed in full and submitted to CARS Tour in accordance with the conditions set forth in this entry form. However, any entrant who performs an act or participates in actions deemed by CARS Tour to be detrimental to the sport of auto racing or the CARS Tour, or fails to abide by the provisions of this entry form, shall be subject to loss of CARS Tour Championship points and/or fine and/or suspension.

Car Owner and Driver, individually and collectively, acknowledge that they have read and understand all terms and conditions of the Official Entry Form, the Rule Book and all Special Rules published by CARS Tour for this Event, and that they will abide by all such terms and conditions, as they may be amended from time to time and by all decisions by CARS Tour or its Officials interpreting and applying them.
